Lessons and Practices: Reflection

- Being a good supervisor requires multiple levels of reflection;
 - On the organization as a whole
 - On myself
 - On those I'm supervising
 - On our projects/relationships
 - On the complex interaction of all the elements at play

Lessons and Practices: Critical Thinking

- The most powerful way to promote and support traits and values in a staff is to **MODEL** them

Lessons and Practices: Systems Thinking

- It's not just about the supervisor and staff relationship; it's about the organizational system in which the relationship takes place

Lessons and Practices: Creativity

- **Aspire to build a workplace that promotes flow and self-actualization**

Lessons and Practices: Dialogue

- Every difficult conversation includes three conversations:
 - The What Happened Conversation
 - The Feelings Conversation
 - The Identity Conversation:
How this affects my view of myself

Beyond Supervision: Developing a Model of Reflective Practice

- Read a text, hear a story, listen to a talk, have a conversation
- Reflect on the learning involved
- Translate the lessons learned onto reference cards
- Carry special reference cards I really want to focus on in my notebook
- Pick one or two reference cards per week and make a special effort to reflect on and apply them

Next Steps

- Texts from this semester – Keep revisiting and exploring them for tools/inspiration
- Supervision – Continue to reflect on my approach and apply lessons learned
- Reflective Practice – Keep building my reference card library, reflect on how best to use it, continually focus on truly incorporating reflective practice into my daily life
